

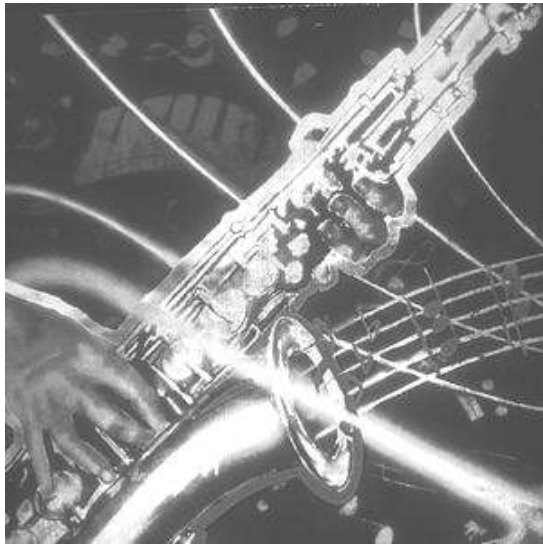
THE NAU JAZZ INSTITUTE

At Curry Summer Music Camp

The NAU Jazz Institute will take place during the Curry Summer Music Camp at NAU, from June 29th to July 12th. Musicians in the Jazz Institute will participate in a completely jazz-specific curriculum, including Big Band and small Combo ensembles, as well as Jazz History, Literature, Theory, and Improvisation classes, while enjoying the same social and extracurricular activities as the traditional Curry Summer Music Camp students. A musician attending the Jazz Institute will not be required to perform in any non-jazz ensembles (although the option is available if so desired).

FACULTY

Faculty at the NAU Jazz Institute consists of nationally and regionally renowned artists and teachers, including Joel DiBartolo (Bass), Dr. Stephen Dunn (trpt), Devon Bridgewater (History and Literature), Barb Catlin (Piano and Theory), Andrew Hake (drums), Adam Roberts (sax), and Steve McCallister (trb).



AUDITIONS

Auditions for the Jazz Institute will be by audio recording, mailed directly to the Curry Summer Music Camp on or before March 31, 2008. Audition guidelines will be available beginning January 1, 2008 at:

Enrollment in the Jazz Institute is limited to a total of 40 musicians, and is open only to those students who will be entering 9th through 12th grades in Fall 2008, as well as those who graduated from High School in Spring 2008. The Jazz Institute is open to Alto, Tenor, and Bari Saxophones, Trumpets, Tenor and Bass Trombones, Piano, Guitar, Bass, and Drums.

REGISTRATION

Registration for all music campers opens on February 1, 2008. To register for the Jazz Institute, please do not mail registration materials or fees until you have been informed that you are accepted based off of your recorded audition. If you wish to attend Curry Summer Music Camp as a traditional camper if you are not accepted to the Jazz Institute, you may mail registration and fees at any time.

Once you have been accepted to the Jazz Institute, we will ask you to send your Curry Summer Music Camp registration materials and payment. At that time, you will follow the same procedure as a normal camper, and simply designate on your registration form that you are attending the Jazz Institute. Jazz Institute fees are the same as those for the traditional Senior Camp attendees.
